Black dustbin Emptied every 2 or 4 weeks

- vacuum cleaner bags
- nappies
- sweepings / rubbish
- cigarette ends
- ashes
- wood
- sanitary towels, tampons
- wallpaper remains
- carpet remains
- rubber
- scraps of cloth
- sticking plaster
- bandages
- tooth brushes
- plastic coathangers
- plastic toys
- candles
- leather goods
- bones
- pet litter



Bio dustbin

Emptied every 2 weeks, in summer every week

- fruit and vegetable
- remains
- pot-plants
- coffee filters and tea bags
- cooked leftovers
- eggshells
- windfall
- leaves
- grass cuttings
- hedge cuttings
- crumpled paper
- flowers

Important!

only kitchen and garden waste! no liquids!

wrap cooked leftovers into newspaper!

Attention! don't use plastic bags, also no plastic bags, which are biodegradable!



Paper/cardboard

Emptied every 4 weeks, collection station

- newspapers, magazines
- catalogues, brochures
- writing-paper
- printed matters
- envelopes
- bags for sugar and flour

Achtung!

Packing materials made of paper or cardboard, even with "green credit" belong to paper/cardboard!

Yellow bag/dustbin

Emptied every 2 weeks

- yoghurt pots
- plastic bottles (e.g. shampoo)
- polystyrene trays
- plastic foils
- plastic bags
- tins/cans
- drink cartons (milk, juice and others)
- tubes
- aluminium foils
- vacuum packaging
- empty sprays
- drinking tins (without deposit)
- beer bottle tops

Important!

All packing materials have to be completely empty!



Glass

Containers, collection station

- jam jars, cucumber glass
- glassbottles for salad oil,
- vinegar, sauces, vine

Important!

Blue or red glass belongs to green glass! Crystal, plate glass, oven-proof glass, mirrors, ceramics, clay pots or porcelain in the black dustbin!
